Trees on Morningwood

Dead trees have been removed. Limbs will be trimmed this month.

Sand filter

Asphalt path between 108 and Morningwood

Section near the drain pipe has a low point. Worried that standing water may go under path, freeze, lifting and cracking new path. Look at warranty in the contract (J Feinberg).
